3. **FEE EXEMPTION:** Students of families receiving social assistance are eligible for a free locker. Families experiencing momentary financial strain are also able to have membership fees waived on a yearly basis. Please contact us at [lockers@theverein.com](mailto:lockers@theverein.com).
4. **RANDOM ASSIGNMENT:** Please be aware that the lockers are assigned randomly, but we try to keep grade levels together. If your child has health issues requiring a specific locker, please provide a note from their orthopedic doctor.
5. **RECEIVING LOCKER ASSIGNMENTS:** 7<sup>th</sup> grade students will receive their locker assignments at Orientation Day.  
If your student is unable to attend Orientation Day, the Locker Committee will be at the high school the first few days of school for locker assignments and to answer any questions.  
Students in grades 8-12 will receive their locker assignment on the first day of school.
6. **DEPOSIT:** Please ensure your 7th grader or new student brings the €10 deposit (exact change please) to Orientation Day or the first day of school. Deposits are one time only when a student enters the high school.
